[The Somerset on Grace Bay](#) is one of only handful of Caribbean resorts that is honest about giving families what they seek most on a sun vacation – time together and a decidedly unscheduled place to relax and unwind at an uninhibited pace.

In addition to the unscheduled time to build sand castles on the beach, exceptionally large suites ranging from 1,353 to 5,327 square-feet with one to five bedrooms, were specifically designed for large families, as well as multi-generational gatherings. Two swimming pools, with a zero-entry shallow end for toddlers and another with underwater music piped in for teens keep kids safe and engaged.



Building unforgettable family memories at The Somerset includes:

- **Monday “Alice in Wonderland Tea Party”** – afternoon refreshments served in the resort breezeway featuring children’s treats such as fresh-squeezed lemonade, juices, homemade cookies and brownies.
- **Tuesday Clambakes** barefoot on Grace Bay Beach with live music, where Chef Callighen brings a touch of the States to Provo and prepares a crackling sand fire pit that steam cooks mouth watering clams with a Caribbean twist for both guests and local revelers.
- **Wednesday Dive-In Movie Nights** - family film series are shown outdoors by the infinity pool, where Executive Chef Lauren Callighen serves her homemade riffs on classic popcorn with caramel, kettle corn, and nachos, along a selection of irresistible nostalgic candy creations.
- **New Children’s Menu**
- **Kids Eat Free**, for children 12 years and under, from selections on the new Children’s Menu at O’Soleil and LunAsea with each adult entrée ordered.
- **“Children’s Hour” Early Dining**, from 5-8 p.m., served in the casual setting at LunAsea offering tasty but organic, fresh and wholesome dishes that go beyond Nuggets and Fries, although they have them too.
- **Hands-on Cookie Baking** sessions for kids, which will then be delivered to their rooms at bedtime with organic milk.

- **En Suite Family Pizza Chef** (added cost), Executive Chef Lauren Callighen's homemade pizza fixings delivered to the suite's gourmet kitchen.
- **Finding Nemo**, complimentary snorkel equipment for exploring the underwater world of tropical fish life found in the calm, shallow waters in front of The Somerset beach, one of the Caribbean's clearest reef areas.
- **Babysitting Service**, provided by certified and warm staff of The Somerset.
- **Children's Welcome Gift**, for all little guests upon arrival.
